

FOOTBALL CHINCHILLA PLAYERS AGREEMENT 2011

MEMBERSHIP

This agreement relates to the membership of _____ and his/her supporting persons (parent, grandparent, guardian, etc). The supporting persons accept the offer made by the club for their child to play soccer and agree to the following conditions upon which membership of the club is based. Please read carefully as you will need to sign at the end of this agreement that you support the conditions. The conditions are designed for the harmonious running of the club in accordance with safety and best interests of the players.

EXPECTATIONS

1. I will make myself aware of the club handbook. This can be found on the website.
2. Players are responsible for their own equipment including water bottles. Players must have their proper safety equipment in order to participate in training and / or games. The club will not be able to supply these.
3. I will abide by the Codes of Conduct – these are to be found in the newsletter, intranet, etc. All conflicts will be addressed by way of the conflict resolution process under Club Policy.
4. Responsibilities of any person fulfilling volunteer roles within the club: (a) designated committee members will follow the position descriptions outlined in the volunteer handbook (b) volunteers will follow the volunteer guidelines as outlined in the handbook.
5. Coaches and other designated personnel have responsibility only at the times and places as outlined in the newsletter or other notification. **In this day of mobile phones, parents must be able to organise other means of transport for their child/ren even when an emergency arises.**
6. Supporters are required to work supportively of the club in the form of working bees, rosters, fundraising and meeting attendance. It is expected that supporters of the club will behave in a positive manner towards all players, coaches, and those holding office. Concerns may be raised appropriately to the committee so that they can be handled properly.

FEES AND EXPENSES

1. The club is a non-profit organisation. Charges involved are
 - (a) annual registration fee (This year's fee is \$110, if paid by sign-up day, or \$130 to be paid before first competition game which includes affiliation, insurance, and club administration costs)
 - (b) expenses in obtaining uniforms, etc.
 - (c) expenses involved with representative games, if selected. (This includes a fee for registration at the carnival / event.)
2. Fees are per child and are as outlined below:
 1. Football Australia \$11.50
 2. Football Qld fees: \$24.50
 3. Football SWQ Zone fees: \$18
 4. Football Toowoomba Inc. fees: \$41.50
 5. Admin/Trophies / referees fees: \$14.50
3. Parents may pay on registration or opt for the instalment plan at the discretion of the current committee. Any other discounts or fee alterations will also be at the discretion of the current committee on an individual player to player basis.
4. Scholarships may be offered in instances where supporters can show exceptional hardship. This is at the discretion of the current committee.

LEGAL ISSUES

1. Football Chinchilla is an association under Law and all legal requirements will be complied with. Football Queensland standards and requirements will also be adhered to.
2. Cautionary offences as outlined by FFA are adopted by the club. See cautionary offences in newsletter, net, and handbook. This applies to adults as well as players.
3. If, in the reasonable opinion of the committee, harm is caused by an adult to a child, notification will be made under Child Protection Laws to Police and Dept of Child Safety.
4. The club requires all members who work in close interaction with players to have the Blue Card. Application forms will be provided and lodged by the secretary.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. **At club level**, the criteria for the selection of teams will be outlined in the By Laws and will be in accordance with the Constitution, the objects of our Constitution and the objects of Football Queensland. A neutral process will be followed in order to develop all players in the club and offer opportunities to elite players. Players are required to attend 90% of training unless excuse is offered.
2. **For representative team selection**, the criteria for the selection of representative occasions is outlined in the By Laws and will be in accordance with the Constitution and the objects of Football Queensland.
