Carnivals – Please remember that our club follows a selection process for Representative Carnivals. (This is outlined in the Players Contract ALL parents signed at the start of the season).

1. **The Dalby Carnivals are for all players. Therefore all players have the opportunity of attending 2 carnivals per year. Substitutions will be made evenly (ie all players should have equal amounts of time on the field).**

2. **The other carnivals held within our zone are Representative Occasions. COACHES/MANAGERS:** This means that the Coaches and Managers of the age group INVITE players (preferably via a letter). If the required number of invited players falls short, **then other players will be asked to attend.** (The club then submits a nomination and fee to attend). **PARENTS: Please note the following before agreeing to attend:** SUBSTITUTIONS will be different to weekly club games.

Representative Carnivals will play their competitive team – players will play in positions that the coaches feel make up the strongest team and substitutions are not always made evenly amongst all players.

Please consider your confirmation of offers to attend carnivals. It is not good form to cancel at the last moment due to insufficient numbers. Once we receive answers from parents the committee nominates on your behalf.
